AUSL provides a \$22,100 resident scholarship paid directly to you that you can use to cover tuition or living costs.

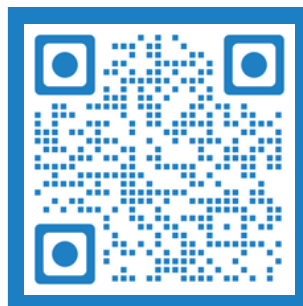
